Wembley National Stadium Trust (WNST) is an independent grant-making trust funded by Wembley National Stadium Ltd. WNST are giving Brent's local clubs, groups and larger organisations the opportunity to apply for funding for sports projects within the Borough- An excellent opportunity!

WNST focus is towards clubs, groups and organisations either based in LB Brent or already providing a service for people living there.

In summary, there are two programmes:

Community Awards – grants of up to £2,500 for local clubs and groups

**Strategic Awards** – larger grants to more established organisations to support more substantial projects.

Both schemes can make awards for either capital or revenue expenditure.

## The deadline for the receipt of applications on both programmes is 5pm on Friday 7th December.
